GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR TEALBY CEMETERY

- 1. Graves shall be turfed flat and no curbs are permitted around a graves plot perimeter.
- 2. The Council reserve the right to level any graves which are not flat.
- 3. No **trees, shrubs or flowers** may be planted.
- 4. No **other decorations** are allowed without prior written permission of the Parish Council.
- 5. Only headstones, tablets and vases may be erected.
- 6. Headstones to be no more than 1 metre high x 75cm wide x 75mm deep and to be fixed on an approved solid foundation 75cm long x 30cm wide x 100mm deep. The foundation must not protrude above ground level.
- 7. Graves must settle for a period of at least 6 months before headstones can be erected.
- 8. Memorial tablets should be 45cm x 45cm square
- 9. Dogs are not allowed in the Cemetery unless on a lead and all waste must be picked up.
- Purchased graves, that are no longer required, must be sold back to the Parish
 Council at the same price they were purchased for.
- 11. Purchased graves cannot be sold to a third party.
- 12. Unwanted graves can be transferred to a close relative only; i.e. Sibling, Child or Spouse, with prior written permission of the Parish Council.
